And because there was usually only one doll with me on an average four-day trip, the couture confection would literally get flushed down the toilet to make way for the next. Since then, Jian, as well as #habetissuewilltravel has now been to over 20 cities in 11 countries. In two short years, the dresses have been discovered, and extensively featured in publications from VOGUE to NYLON, from blogs to broadsheets and tabloids.
