response whether positive or negative feb 11 2021 in behavioral psychology reinforcement is a technique that is responsible for learned behavior reinforce means to strengthen or to encourage the four types of reinforcement include positive reinforcement this involves adding something to increase response such as praising a child when they complete a designated task this would motivate the term reinforce means to strengthen and is used in psychology to refer to any stimuli which strengthens or increases the probability of a specific response for example if you want your dog to sit on command you may give him a treat every time he sits for you noun the act of reinforcing the state of being reinforced something that reinforces or strengthens often reinforcements an additional supply of personnel ships aircraft etc for a military force mar 15 2021 a reinforcement or reinforcer is any stimulus or event which increases the probability of the occurrence of a desired
