desert state park the arroyo tapiado carrizo badlands mud caves are the largest known cave system in the country with 22 caves and 9 slot canyons to explore 2 synonyms for cave cavern grotto tunnel abyss lair pit delve grot antonyms of cave protect guard fence keep secure defend screen cover the cave which was uncovered by excavations in the 1950s houses a small altar and is overlooked by a carmelite monastery constructed by the christian religious order he inspired christians also believe that jesus and his family sheltered in the same cave on their return from egypt while escaping from king herod plural caves 1 a natural chamber or series of chambers in the earth or in the side of a hill or cliff 2 a usually underground chamber for storage a wine cave also the articles stored there 3 cave also called cavern natural opening in the earth large enough for human exploration such a cavity is formed in many types of rock and by many processes the

largest and most common caves are those formed by chemical reaction between circulating groundwater and bedrock composed of limestone or dolomite a cave or cavern is a natural void in the ground specifically a space large enough for a human to enter caves often form by the weathering of rock and often extend deep underground a veil of darkness cloaks the natural beauty of caves some are found in cliffs at the edge of the coastline chipped away by the relentless pounding of waves others form where a lava tube s 18 hours ago the civilian conservation corps constructed the road and buildings for colossal cave southeast of tucson in the mid 1930s robert l houston courtesy of ray mcguire the park s retaining wall 1 day ago the cave at leo carrillo state beach within leo carrillo state park is one of the easiest to access to find the cave park in the lot closest to the park entrance guard hut
