moon phases moon in motion moon nasa science Jul 25 2022 web the moon is opposite the sun as viewed from earth revealing the moon s dayside a full moon rises around sunset and sets around sunrise the moon will appear full for a couple of days before it moves into waning gibbous as the moon begins its journey back toward the sun the opposite side of the moon now reflects the moon s light
